RESOLUTION TO APPROVE PROTECTION PROGRAM LOAN

WHEREAS, Article 16 of the New York Not-For-Profit Corporation Law, Section 1607(a) (4) empowers the Land Bank to borrow money at such rates of interest as the Land Bank may determine; and

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the U.S. Small Business Administration has established several financial and lending programs to assist nonprofits including the Payroll Protection Program; and

WHEREAS, the Land Bank has suffered economic stress due to the COVID-19 Pandemic and wishes to apply for economic assistance in the form of a loan through the Payroll Protection Program in the amount of \$17,000; and

WHEREAS, the Land Bank Board and staff has had the opportunity to review the terms and conditions of the Payroll Protection Program and wish to apply through Pioneer Bank, the Land Bank's Banking Institution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE TROY COMMUNITY LAND BANK, AS FOLLOWS:

The recitals above are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

- 1. The Members of the Board hereby authorize the Executive Director Anthony Tozzi, and the Chairman on such terms and conditions as he/she/they may deem proper, to borrow pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Payroll Protection Act from its lender Pioneer Bank the sum of \$17,000.00 and to sign, execute, and endorse all such documents as may be required by said bank to evidence such indebtedness; and
- _2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
